Stroke Nurse Service

IND Case study: Hong Kong

- The Hong Kong Stroke Nurse role has evolved to encompass combined roles as case manager, facilitator, tissue plasminogen activator nurse.
 - ✓ As a result: 100% patients admitted with acute stroke receive appropriate investigations and treatment.
 - ✓ 2,500 patients have benefited from this program within 12 months.
 - ✓ This means fewer patients are dying or suffering the long-term effects caused by stroke.
