National COVID Situation: Ethiopia

- The first COVID-19 case was reported on March 13, 2020.
- A total of 3,954 confirmed COVID-19 cases and 65 deaths as of today.
 - It took 77 days to surpass the first 1000 cases;
 - It took only 7 days to record the second thousand cases with an alarming increment of the number of cases in the country.








Daily New Cases in Ethiopia



Total Coronavirus Deaths in Ethiopia








Daily New Deaths in Ethiopia





Fig. 4: Geographical distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases in Ethiopia, as of June 07, 2020

Challenges

- Adherence to NPIs (social distancing ...)
- Health seeking behaviour and facility visits for essential services
- Number of COVID-19 related community deaths detected during dead body testing.
- PPE stock and use especially for health workers
- Panic, Stigma, Infodemics
- Competing health priorities: TB/HIV, NCDs, other outbreaks (YF, ...)




Tikur Anbessa Hospital



Background

- Tikur Anbessa Hospital is the National <u>Referral</u> and <u>Teaching</u> Hospital for Ethiopia
- ~ 1000 bed capacity
- > 2500 health workers
- Preparation to respond to COVID started early and well structure
- Readiness assessments conducted, scenariobased planning, continuous monitoring.
