




Unprecedent scope all sectors are involved. Addresses the three pillars of sustainable development: social, environmental and economic dimensions.

progress in one area is related to progress in other areas.


Inclusive aiming to "leave no one behind".




Through national and subnational policies and plans, governments harmonizing policies and processes to faciliatate achievement of the SDGs
