Migration: How big is it?

- · ~1 billion
 - 1 in every 7 individuals
 - 272 million international migrants1



Types of Migration/Migrants

- · Reason: Forced migrants/migration Vs. Voluntary
 - · Refugees, asylum seekers, irregular migrants Vs. Labour, family, study
- Geographical distribution: Internal Vs. International/external migrants
- Duration: temporary Vs. "Permanent"
 - · Seasonal workers, students, family resettlement






Boxplot of death rate ratios (emergency death rates over baseline death rates), by displacement status

However, migrants influences and are influenced by all SDGs
















- 9 main targets
