

A Summary Profile of ODA Support for CSOs by the United States, 2023 DAC CRS Data

This profile of official support for CSOs by the United States provides context for the current 90-day freeze on all ODA financing by the US government and the seeming closure of USAID, with perhaps some aspects of its programming integrated into the US Department of State. But the future of US aid and its priorities is currently unknown. The immediate consequences are catastrophic for the thousands of civil society organizations and their staff receiving US ODA for their programs as well as millions of people around the world who were participant in these programs.

The data is derived from the latest year (2023) in the DAC Creditor Reporting System [cloud replica] for gross disbursements. It focuses on allocations to and through CSOs by the US government. While the allocations for US ODA at the time of these dramatic cuts in January 2025 will be somewhat different, this profile gives a substantial picture of the potential implications for civil society worldwide. All amounts are current 2023 US dollars.

1. US ODA as a share of total DAC ODA

US ODA accounted for just under a third of DAC donor ODA in 2023, particularly discounting Ukraine.

US ODA is 27% of DAC Gross ODA Disbursements in 2023 (loans included at face value). (DAC1)

US ODA is 29% of DAC Net ODA Disbursements in 2023 (grant equivalency for loans). (DAC1)

US ODA is 32% of DAC Net ODA Disbursements in 2023, less support for Ukraine. (DAC2a)
